Services are sung daily while thousands come to enjoy the Cathedral's many concerts and organ recitals including the very popular (and free) weekly lunchtime concerts.



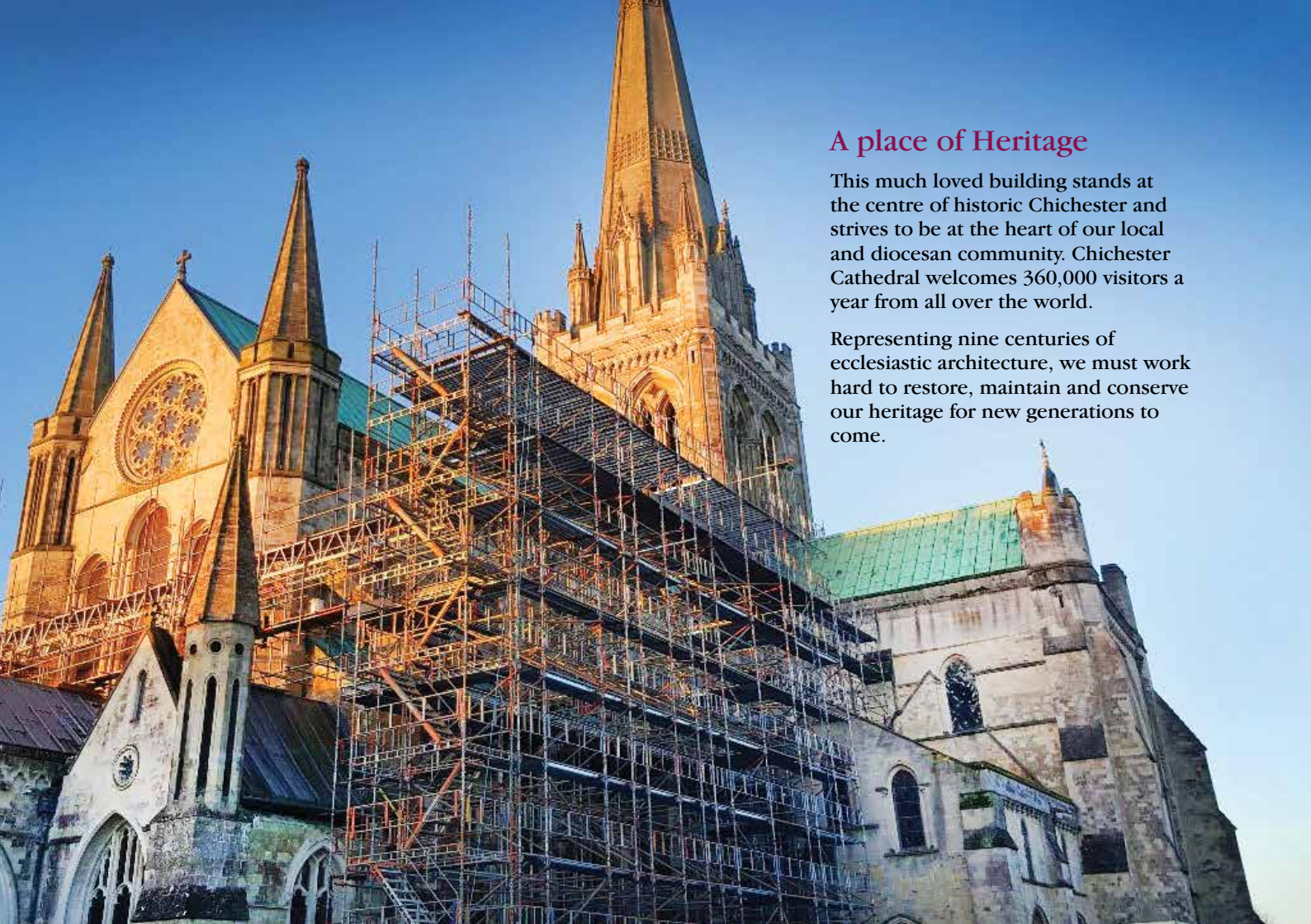




A place for Community

A place of Heritage

This much loved building stands at the centre of historic Chichester and strives to be at the heart of our local and diocesan community. Chichester Cathedral welcomes 360,000 visitors a year from all over the world.

Representing nine centuries of ecclesiastic architecture, we must work hard to restore, maintain and conserve our heritage for new generations to come.

Below are three types of legacy gift:

- **A Residuary Legacy** a portion, or everything that remains after other specific gifts, expenses and taxes have been paid.
- **A Pecuniary Legacy** a specified sum of money.
- **A Specific Legacy** a specific item such as property or an alternative item.
